By special permission, part of it will be routed through The Sevenoaks Wild Fowl Reserve. Part of the course will be on a private road for a short section.
There will be a shortened course for Class 5.

Novice Class

- 1) Any driver who has not won more than two club One Day Events

Open Class

- 1) Any driver who has progressed from Novice
- 2) Any driver who has competed at National level.
- 3) Any driver who has driven a multiple turnout.

Short Course

- 1) This will be open to any driver (course approx. 2-3km)
- 2) Drivers **must do** the Pre-novice Dressage Test

Classes may be amalgamated / divided at the discretion of the show organisers.
Rules will follow the BCD rules with local variations.

No motor vehicles will be allowed on the course at any time unless authorised.
Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
